






AN ACT TO ADD A SECTION 229 TO THE
GOVERNMENT CODE OF GUAM TO DESIGNATE
THE FIRST WEEK IN JUNE AS ATBOT DE
FUEGO (FLAME TREE) AND ARBOR DAY WEEK.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 229 is hereby added to the Government
3 Code of Guam to read as follows:

4 "Section 229. Atbot de Fuego (Flame Tree) and
5 Arbor Day Week. The first week of June in each year shall
6 be known as Atbot de Fuego (Flame Tree) and Arbor Day
7 Week in commemoration of the natural beauty of the flame
8 trees of Guam. The Governor of Guam shall issue a
9 proclamation calling upon the people of Guam to observe
10 such event and shall arrange for appropriate ceremonies
11 for the observance of such week."

12 Section 2. Section 4 is hereby added to Public Law 12-46
13 to read as follows:

14 "Section 4. The provisions of this Act shall not
15 apply to causes of action which arise on or before the
16 effective date of this Act."
