



Introduced by E. R. Duenas

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 26007 AND TO ADD
A NEW SECTION 26009.1 ALL OF CHAPTER V OF
TITLE XXVII (PUBLIC LAW 12-209) OF THE
GOVERNMENT CODE RELATIVE TO THE LISTING
OF PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS OF THE GUAM
TERRITORIAL PARK SYSTEM.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE TERRITORY OF GUAM:

2 Section 1. Section 26007 (Public Law 12-209) of the
3 Government Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 "Section 26007. Guam Territorial Park System. There
5 is hereby created the Guam Territorial Park System. The
6 Director of Parks and Recreation shall inventory all
7 properties belonging to the government of Guam and
8 determine which properties shall be included therein. A
9 detailed list shall be forwarded to the Speaker of the
10 Legislature and the Legislature shall, after public
11 hearing and report by the appropriate standing committee,
12 approve or disapprove those properties to be included
13 within the Territorial Park System, as designated under
14 Section 26009.1, within thirty (30) legislative days
15 following receipt of such a list and failure to so act
16 shall be deemed consent by the Legislature. The list
17 shall be added to or deleted as deemed necessary."

18 Section 2. A new Section 26009.1 is hereby added to the
19 Government Code to read as follows:

1 "Section 26009.1. Reserved properties. Pursuant
2 to Sections 26007 and 26009 of this Chapter, the below
3 described properties are reserved for public parks
4 according to their respective classifications in
5 numerical order:

6 (a) Natural Preserves:

7 (b) Conservation Reserves:

8 (c) Territorial Parks or Community Parks:

9 (d) Territorial Recreation Facilities

10 or Community Recreation Facilities:

11 (e) Historical and Pre-Historic Objects
12 and Sites:"

13 Section 3. This is an urgency measure.
